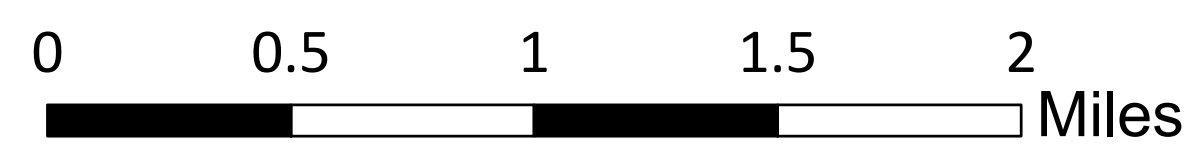
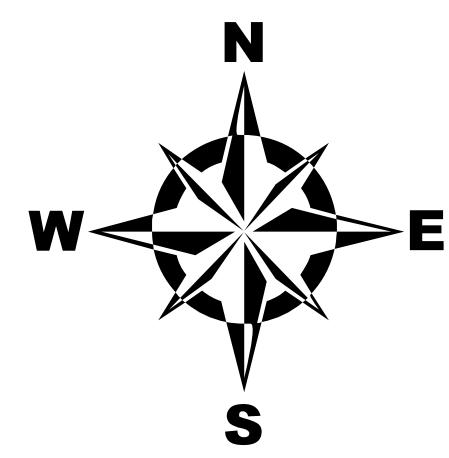


TOWN OF SUTTON NEW HAMPSHIRE Hazard Mitigation Plan 2019 Map 1: Potential Hazards
